

The journey by train takes you along the highest mountains of Switzerland and allows guests to admire the unique nature of the Alps. Trains generally depart every half an hour.



Access to the Matterhorn village by private transportation is not permitted, however, this does not mean you cannot get there by coach or car. From Täsch, the shuttle train brings guests straight to Zermatt in only 12 minutes.



Most of the attractions within the village are in walking distance. To avoid having to carry luggage or ski equipment, guests can grab a taxi or the public bus (green & red line) directly at the train station. All tickets of the Zermatt Bergbahnen entitle to the free use of these electric buses.



ZERMATT – TROCKENER STEG Matterhorn-Express | gondola

With comfortable 8-seater gondolas and a capacity of 2'800 people per hour, guests glide over Furi and Schwarzsee to Trockener Steg at 2'939 metres above sea level.



TROCKENER STEG – Matterhorn glacier paradise

Glacier ride | 3S cableway The superlative cable car floats over the perpetual ice and takes guests to 3'883 metres above sea level. It just feels like flying.



FURI – RIFFELBERG Riffelberg-Express | gondola

The two most famous excursion destinations in Zermatt - the Matterhorn glacier paradise and the Gornergrat, can be admired on the same day thanks to the comfortable 8-seater gondolas of the Riffelberg-Express.



ZERMATT – SUNNEGGA Funicular

The underground funicular with a transport capacity of 2'600 people per hour brings guests to the popular sun terrace within a very short time.



SUNNEGGA – BLAUHERD Gondola (summer) Combi cable car (winter)

With a capacity of 2'220 people per hour, this 8-seater gondola takes our guests up to Blauherd with perfect views of the Matterhorn.








UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE MATTERHORN GLACIER PARADISE

At a breezy 3'883 m.a.s.l./ 12'739 ft metres of altitude you will find Europe's highest cableway and mountain station. Want to go even higher up? The summit elevator will bring you up to the viewing platform, offering a 360° panoramic view that includes 38 giant alpine mountains. A visit to the world's highest glacier palace will make this excursion an unforgettable experience.



UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE MATTERHORN GLACIER PARADISE



VIEWING PLATFORM

The summit elevator will carry you to the highest viewing platform in the Alps. The 360° panorama offers you views surrounded by 38 four-thousand-metre-high summits and 14 alpine glaciers. As well as serving as a viewpoint with breath-taking visibility all the way to Mont Blanc, the platform is also a place of romance: couples pledge to each other with symbolic love locks which they have carried all the way up.

GLACIER PALACE

Glittering ice crystals and shimmering ice sculptures enchant visitors of the glacier palace. Another elevator brings you 15 metres below the surface to a fairy-tale palace in the heart of the eternal ice. Walk through a glacier crevasse or try out the ice slide, before making yourself comfortable on an ice bench covered with cosy blankets. An activity for small and big explorers alike.





CINEMA LOUNGE

The modern cinema Lounge in the heart of the mountain provides grasping entertainment for film buffs, presenting fascinating footage about alpinism, the alpine world, the flora and fauna, cable cars and railways of the Zermatt region. It's the perfect way to get in the mood for the stunning views on top or a great activity for a rainy afternoon.

365 DAYS OF SKIING

Do you think the mountains are only for hikers in the summer? Think again! In Europe's highest and biggest glacier ski area you can ski to your heart's desire, even during the summer season. In Zermatt hikers and skiers share the mountains, it's as simple as that. Between the station of Trockener Steg at 2'929 m.a.s.l. and the Gobba di Rollin, the highest point on the Breithorn plateau at 3'899 m.a.s.l., lies the summer ski area with up to 21 kilometres of slopes.

UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE **TROCKENER STEG**

Trockener Steg lies at an altitude of 2'939 m.a.s.l. and has a very special meaning for visitors to the Matterhorn paradise. At this hub, worlds merge: in summer, the ski slopes end there, and the hiking trails begin. Skiers and hikers come together. The view glides from the Matter valley up to the Matterhorn.

THE CABLE CAR OF SUPERLATIVES – GLACIER RIDE

It takes us up to an altitude of nearly 4'000 metres: the «Matterhorn glacier ride», the world's highest 3S cable car (three-rope gondola). Both, the alpine destination at the Matterhorn glacier paradise, as well as the journey itself are stunning. The spacious cabins, each with 28 heated seats, ensure passengers to travel with the highest levels of comfort, the panoramic windows offer impressive views of the alpine scenery around the world-famous Matterhorn, and the almost three-kilometre-long traverse of the Theodul Glacier is sure to leave every passenger wide-eyed in amazement.

UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE TROCKENER STEG



CRYSTAL RIDE

For even greater luxury, thousands of Swarovski crystals glitter like fresh snow in the sunlight in four of the 25 cabins. During the journey to the highest cableway mountain station in Europe, the four special "Crystal ride" cabins reveal a spectacular view. Three minutes after the departure, at a height of 170 metres above the ground, the previously opaque glass floor clears in a matter of seconds to offer a dramatic view onto the glacier landscape below. So, keep your camera handy and your nerves calm!

INFOCUBE

The InfoCube on Trockener Steg is worth a visit in any weather. The exhibition presents technical background information on the existing and future cable car projects interactively in German and English. The InfoCube is open all year round and the admission is free of charge.





MATTERHORN GLACIER TRAIL

Hike along the glacier, enjoying the breathtaking mountain scenery. Between Trockener Steg and Schwarzsee there are 23 points of interest which describe the natural phenomenon of the alpine glaciers and explain the history of the Furgg glacier.



UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE SCHWARZSEE

Step out of your everyday life and into your hiking shoes, and take the cable car up to Schwarzsee! It's that easy, and you'll be so close to the «myth of the Matterhorn» that you can even feel it. Regardless of the time of year – a hike around Schwarzsee makes you want to discover more.



LAKE SCHWARZSEE

Once you have reached the peak, it's worth spending some time here and to let your eyes wander. At 2'583 m.a.s.l., at the foot of the Matterhorn, lies the idyllic mountain lake of which the surface sometimes appears almost black. Walk along the Schwarzsee to visit the small chapel «Maria zum See» and if your look up, you will be facing the imposing north wall of the Matterhorn and the famous Hörnlihütte.

MATTERHORN TRAIL

Along the beautiful Matterhorn Trail, from Schwarzsee to Zermatt, you will find ten sites telling tales of the Matterhorn. Each site features a woodcarving by the sculptor Marcel Eyer.



UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE **SCHWARZSEE**



HÖRNLI TRAIL

The hike from Schwarzsee to the famous Hörnli mountain hut is a particularly impressive experience. However, caution is required, sure-footedness and sturdy hiking boots are a must. Nevertheless you will be richly rewarded for the ascent to an altitude of 3'260 metres. At the Hörnli mountain hut, the «myth Matterhorn» is clearly noticeable. You have never been so close to the mountain of mountains!

PHOTO POINT «ZERMATT»

A very special souvenir photo can be taken on Schwarzsee, all year round. Not only for skiers, but also for Matterhorn lovers, this photo point is a real must. Convince yourself!





DIRT SCOOTER

A spectacular descent for thrill seekers: take the Matterhorn-Express up to Schwarzsee and speed down into the valley on your dirt scooter. Along the way you will find several restaurants where you can enjoy a hearty snack. A day outdoors for the entire family, with fun and action guaranteed!



UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE FURI

The hamlet of Furi is located at the exact spot where the Gorner glacier once covered the landscape in perpetual ice. Today the landscape is characterised by meadows, larch forests and gentle rocks – and of course the distinctive traces left by the glacier.

The Furi mountain station lies at an altitude of 1'867 metres. Cattle are said to have grazed on the surrounding meadows hundreds of years ago. The old wooden barns indeed give you the impression that you have been taken back to the past. As you can see, there are many stories to tell on Furi. And even more to experience!

SUSPENSION BRIDGE

A bridge – 100 metres long – spans across the Gorner gorge, high above the raging waters – or, to be precise, 90 metres above. Looking down is not for the faint-hearted! Another highlight is waiting on the other side: the Dossen glacier garden.



UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURES START HERE FURI



GLACIER GARDEN

Welcome to the ice age! In the Dossen glacier garden you will discover glacial pools that were formed 4'000 years ago, a mysterious rock cave and much more. A barbecue area, fireplaces and a nearby children's playground provide relaxation, nature experiences and a welcomed change from everyday life.

GORNER GORGE

The natural beauty of the Gorner gorge can be admired by walking on especially constructed wooden footbridges. If you are looking for thrills, you can even dare to cross the gorge with a mountain guide. After your hike along the gorge, you should definitely visit the hamlet «Blatten». The Ricola herb garden and the old Valaisan barns are just waiting to be discovered by you!





MOOS TRAIL


The way to Furi can be covered either by bike or by cable car. The easy flow country trail is quickly mastered and can easily be completed several times. Afterwards you are surely well prepared for the more demanding flow trail on Sunnegga!





THE BEST VIEWS OF THE MATTERHORN **ROTHORN**

The view from the Rothorn provides a panoramic scenery of the highest peaks of the Valaisan Alps and the classical view of the world-famous Matterhorn. In summer, the Rothorn is the starting point for many hiking tours and also the location for the popular sunrise ascent. It's worth it to get up early to enjoy this breath-taking nature experience.

PEAK COLLECTION

The peak of the Rothorn at 3'103 metres above sea level offers the most spectacular view reaching from the village of Zermatt over to the Matterhorn. While walking around the restaurant Rothorn, you can breathe the pure mountain air and admire the unique «Peak Collection». This special outdoor exhibition consisting of 18 sculptures will connect you on an artistic level with the alpine world of Zermatt and its mystical tales.

SUNRISE

Start the day with this breath-taking nature experience – an unforgettable adventure awaits you! Our special sunrise offer includes a single or return ticket from Zermatt to the Rothorn.






THE BEST VIEWS OF THE MATTERHORN **BLAUHERD**

If you were looking for a place for the perfect adventure playground in the Swiss Alps, it would probably be exactly where Blauherd is today – on an altitude of 2'571 m.a.s.l., on a sunny plateau between Sunnegga and Rothorn.

The Blauherd mountain station can be reached from Sunnegga in summer by gondola or in winter by the combined cable car with additional chairlifts. Having arrived, the surrounding mountain peaks of Zermatt seem to be welcoming the visitors. After a short greeting to the Matterhorn your adventure can start!





5 LAKES WALK

The 5 Lakes Walk is a must and takes you from Blauherd to Sunnegga, passing by five mountain lakes on the way. You will be captivated by the reflection of the Matterhorn in the waters and by the variety of colourful alpine flowers around the lakes. The lakes Leisee and Grünsee are great spots for a refreshing swim.

MOUNTAIN CART

Racing down the slopes in our mountain carts is fast and furious fun for the adventurous! Start your own mountain cart descent as a unique way to explore the idyllic nature trails around the Matterhorn.



THE BEST VIEWS OF THE MATTERHORN **BLAUHERD**



FLOWER TRAIL

Walk across lush alpine meadows and along vivid dwarf heathers, discover Edelweiss and alpine roses flowering in seemingly bare gravel areas. Less common species are also to be found here, some of them are worldwide rarities. The Flower Trail from Blauherd to Tuftern and back to Sunnegga is a chance to see the magnificent alpine flora from up close. Enjoy the peaceful surroundings of unspoilt nature.

MARMOT TRAIL

Discover the world of the alpine marmots. This walk from Blauherd to Sunnegga will take you past four information boards with observation points. The region around the Rothorn is a particularly good location for watching marmots. They inhabit the area from Sunnegga up to the foot of the Oberrothorn. Who will be the first to spot one?



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ALPINE LOUNGE

Would you like to relax after a long hike or learn more about the environment and sustainability at Zermatt Bergbahnen? All this and much more is possible in the Alpine Lounge. Various seating options, some of them made from old chair lifts, invite you to rest and relax. Do you know what snow-farming is all about or do you know how ice is formed? If not, your next visit to the Alpine Lounge will certainly be informative.

THE BEST VIEWS OF THE MATTERHORN **SUNNEGGA**

Sunnegga – the name is not a coincidence, as it is the most family-friendly peak within the Zermatt-Matterhorn destination as well as the one with the sunniest views. Always with the legendary Matterhorn in sight, the most exciting family adventures are written on the Sunnegga. And all year round, the cuddly mascot Wolli himself accompanies you!

With the Wolli Card, and its numerous advantages for all children under nine years of age, you can comfortably take the underground train from the Sunnegga-Rothorn valley station up to the summit. Once you have arrived, everything is possible: skiing in winter, kick biking, playing, hiking and walking in summer. A peak made for adventurous and active families...

KICK BIKES

Everyone who loves action loves kick biking! The descent on off-road scooters is a tremendous fun for thrill-seekers of all ages. Bikes and helmets can be hired at the valley station of Sunnegga-Rothorn or at the mountain stations. Then you're all set for the downhill adventure!

LAKE LEISEE

The lake Leisee, at an altitude of 2'232 metres, is the beach of the Alps and therefore a popular excursion for the whole family. There's a playground, a water play area, some barbecue sites and picnic spots, a play raft and comfortable wooden recliners – not to mention a stunning view of the Matterhorn.

FLOW TRAIL

The Sunnegga trail in two words: flow and fun! Take the underground train to the starting point just below Sunnegga mountain station. Then, with full speed, heading down through beautiful forests, you reach the village of Zermatt, where the trail comes to an end.





SUNRISE



The Riffelberg lies at 2'582 m.a.s.l. directly below the much better known Gornergrat. However, the Riffelberg is well worth a visit. Upon arrival with the gondolas, the breathtaking view of the mountain of mountains – the Matterhorn – immediately captivates.

Only a few minutes' walk from the station, you can immerse yourself in a world of past times and marvel at the «Bruder Klaus» chapel, inaugurated in 1961. Here you can also find the first mountain hotel of Zermatt.

THE LONGEST SKI RUN IN THE WORLD

The ski run down to the valley is the crowning glory of a successful skiing day. The descent from the highest mountain station of Europe, the Matterhorn glacier paradise, down to the village Zermatt is more than a valley descent. With 25 kilometres, it is the longest prepared run in the world. 2'263 metres in altitude can be mastered without interruption.

MATTERHORN SKI PARADISE WINTER HIKING AND SNOWSHOE TOURS

While skiers romp on the slopes in the Matterhorn ski paradise, pedestrians discover the winter hiking paradise away from the hustle and bustle. Those in search of relaxation, set off on hiking or snowshoe treks to discover fairy-tale winter landscapes. A leisurely winter hike in Zermatt is always a welcomed change from the action on the slopes, even for skiers.

The destination of Zermatt-Matterhorn has more than 70 kilometres of prepared winter hiking paths and snowshoe trails. The snowshoe routes take you on four different trails through the untouched nature of the romantic snow-covered Valaisan Alps. 20 kilometres of the winter hiking trails in Zermatt run above the villages of Täsch and Randa. In Findeln, various mountain restaurants entice visitors to stop for a bite to eat. Over and over again you will stand still in amazement: The view of the Matterhorn is breathtaking from every perspective!



A GLIMPSE INTO THE FUTURE

The opening of the world's highest 3S cable car to the Matterhorn glacier paradise in autumn 2018 was only the beginning of a much greater vision: the continuous aerial cable car connection between Zermatt and Italy, the so-called «Alpine X» (Crossing).

With the «Alpine X», an identical 3S cable car (three ropes) is under construction, connecting Testa Grigia and the Matterhorn glacier paradise. In autumn 2022, visitors will be able to tackle the highest cable car crossing in the Alps for the first time – always with the Matterhorn in sight.

This cable car connection from the Matterhorn glacier paradise (Klein Matterhorn) to Testa Grigia is making a generational dream come true: travelling from the Matterhorn village of Zermatt (CH) to Breuil-Cervina (IT), without getting your feet wet! The future-oriented cable car project will further enhance the attractivity of our region, as well as strengthen Zermatt-Matterhorn as a top high alpine destination. The approximately one-hour panoramic journey from Switzerland to Italy or vice versa spans the highest altitude difference in Europe, with over 4'000 metres of difference in altitude.
