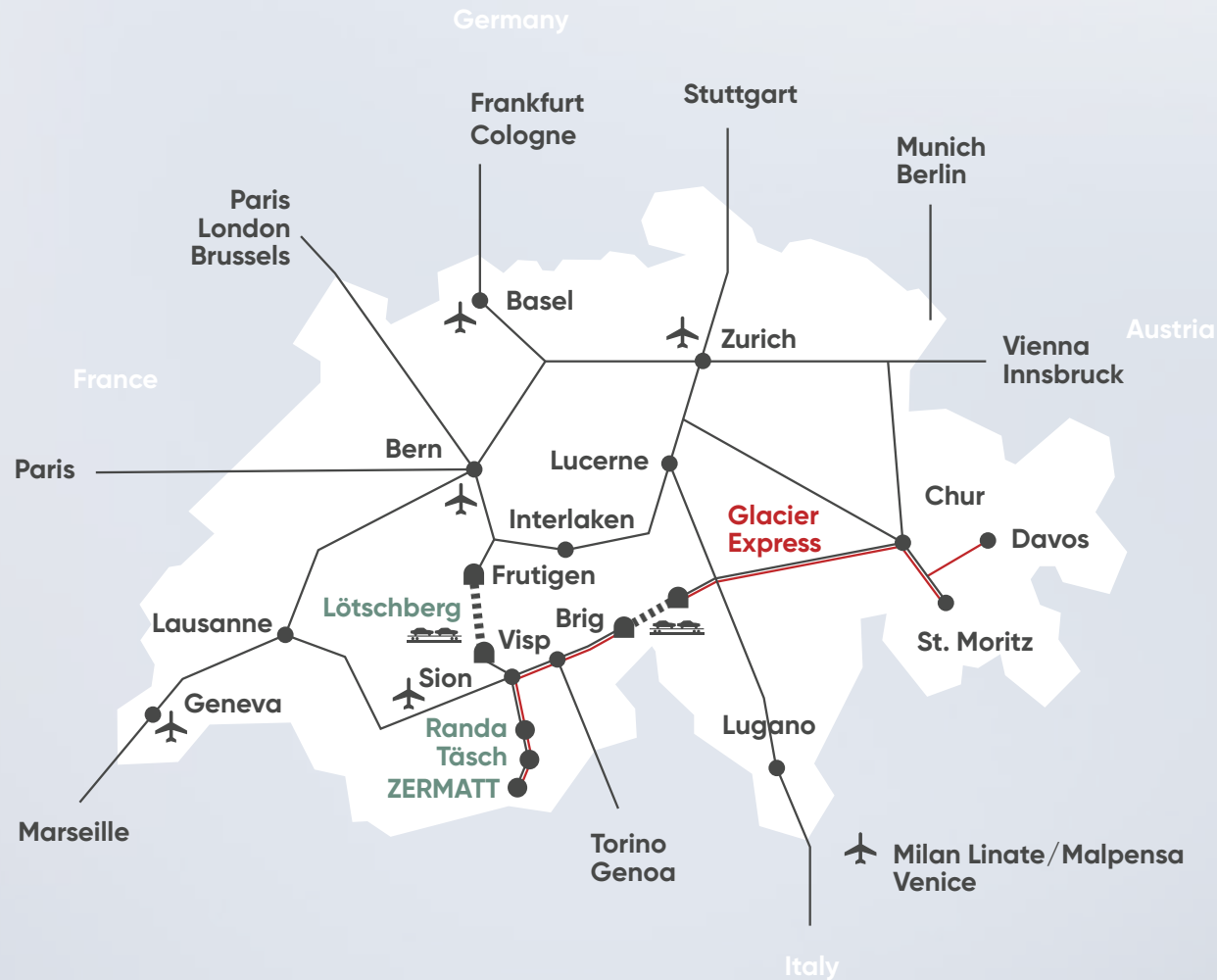

LOTS OF WAYS TO GET TO ZERMATT



Zermatt has always been car-free and the alternative electric cars give the village its very own charm. The Matterhorn Gotthard Railway takes visitors directly to the centre of the village and to the start of the famous Bahnhofstrasse in Zermatt.

The journey for car drivers ends in Täsch, 5 km before Zermatt. From there, train shuttle or taxi options are available to the town at the foot of the Matterhorn.

Guests arriving by plane can take the train to Zermatt. The journey takes 3.5 hours from Zurich-Kloten and from Basel. It takes 4 hours from Geneva-Cointrin.

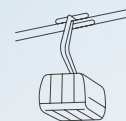

Known for its fantastic views of a unique mountain panorama, Zermatt – Matterhorn is the starting point for three main excursions: Matterhorn Glacier Paradise, Sunnegga/Rothorn and Gornergrat. The three peaks are accessible thanks to the well-developed and state-of-the-art cable car infrastructure, offering breathtaking views of the mountain world around the Matterhorn with its 38 four-thousand-metre peaks. The experience is completed by a wide range of restaurant options.

UNIQUE ALTITUDE

The Matterhorn Ski Paradise is the highest ski area with the highest cable car station in Europe. Its exceptional altitude ensures skiing 365 days a year.

INFINITE EXPANSE

The ski area offers over 360 km of ski slopes that cross national borders. 200 km of these are on the Swiss side and 160 km on the Italian side.

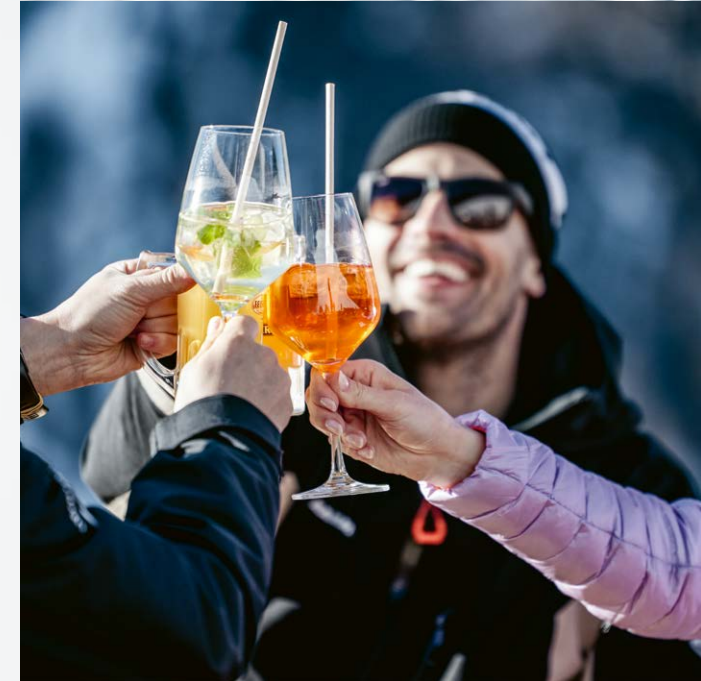
ABUNDANT SUNNY DAYS

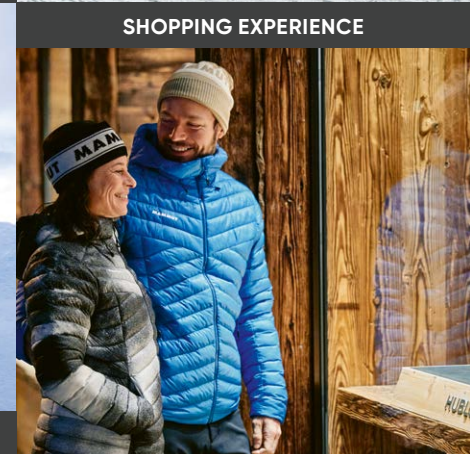

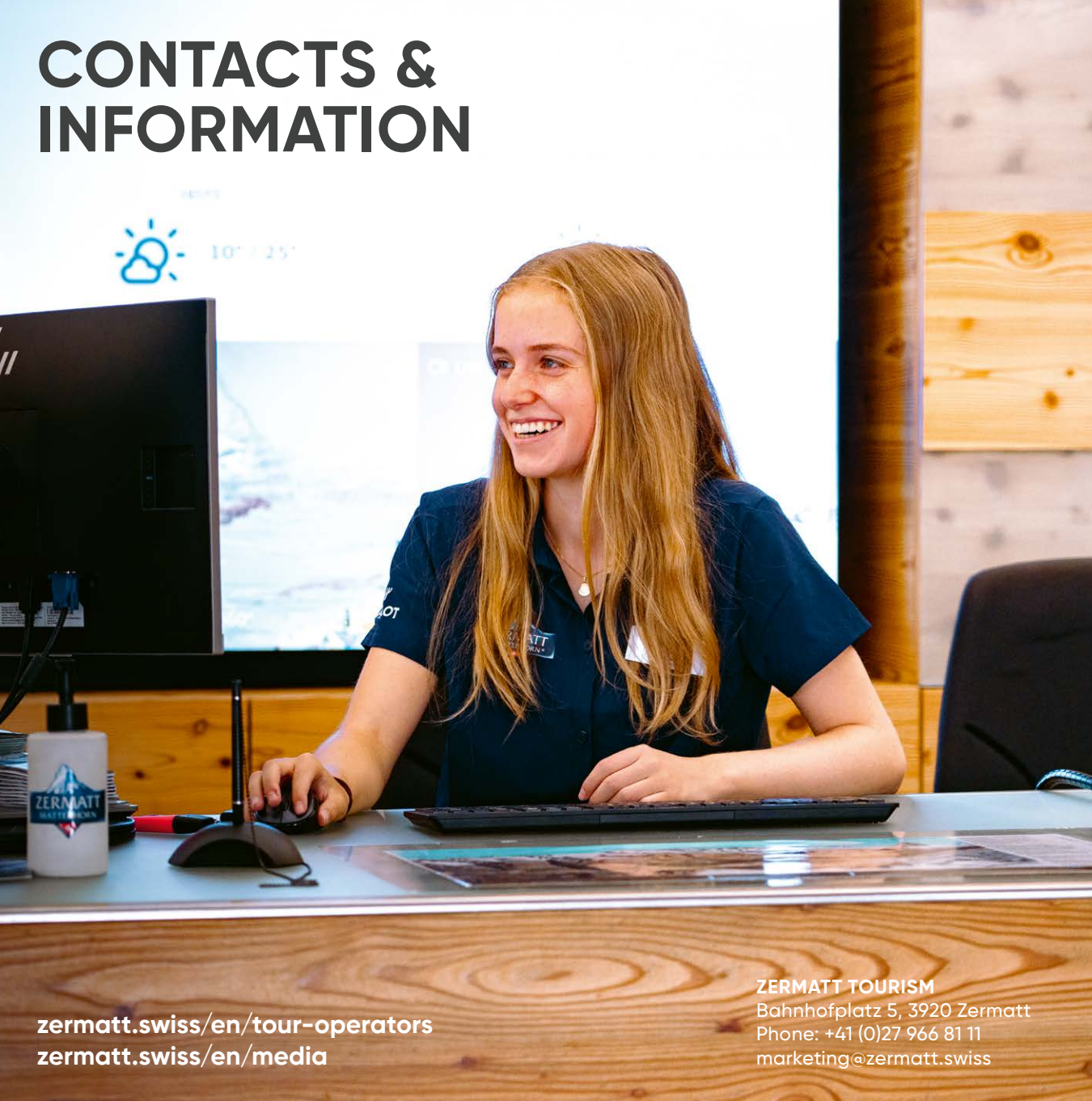
